For Reading: you can simply read from cover to cover and explore the themes, encouragements, and challenges of the part of Scripture the book covers.

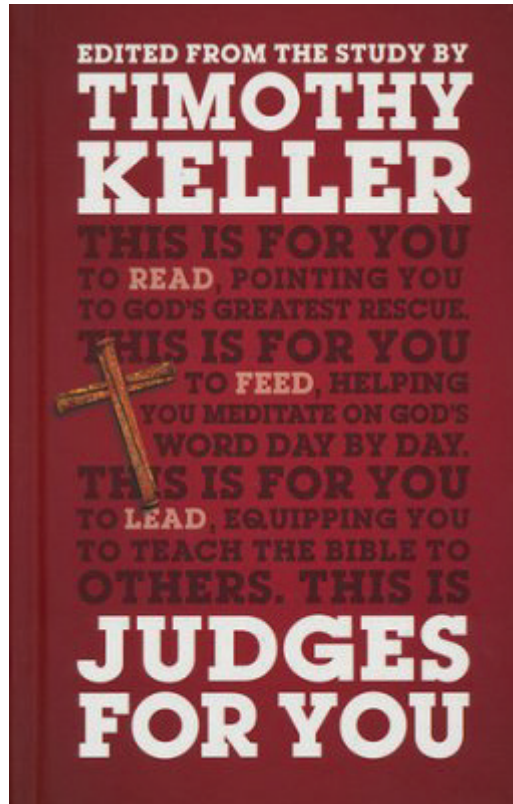
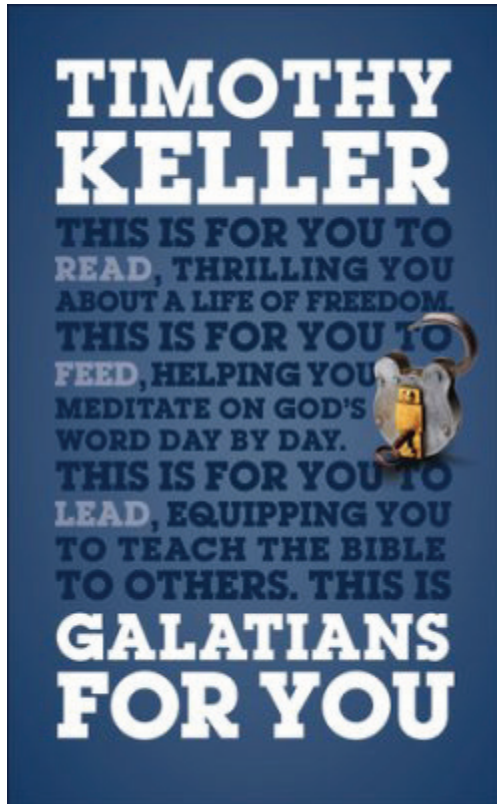

- Easily readable



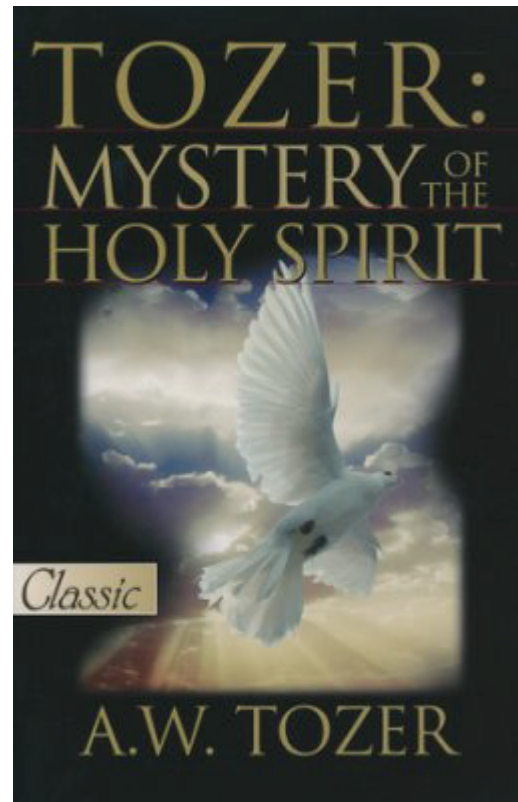
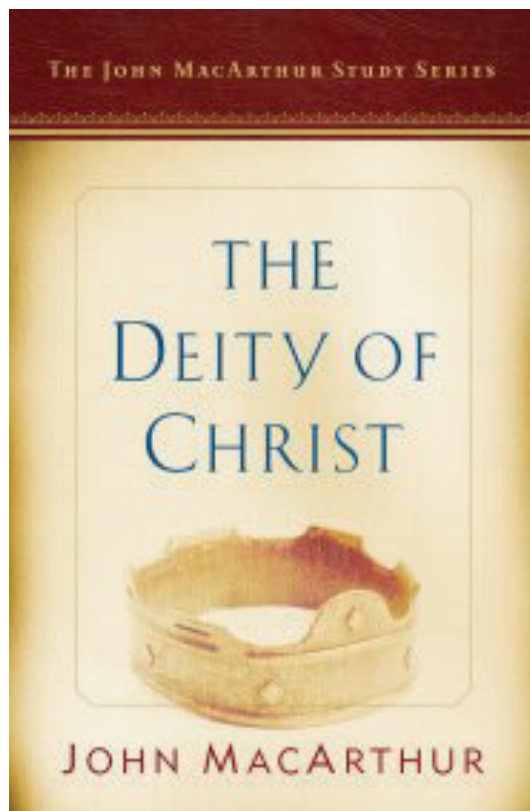
## **Theology 100:**
